

# Enter your number plate for one-hour free parking

From 1 October 2024, on-street parking in the central city will be free for the first hour.

Even if you're staying less than an hour, **you must enter your number plate** at a kiosk or on the PayMyPark app.






Use a **yellow** kiosk if you've parked in the **yellow** zone.  
Or a **green** kiosk if you've parked in the **green** zone.

On-street parking Mon - Sat, 8am - 8pm	First hour	Second hour	Third hour onwards
<b>Yellow zone</b>	<b>Free</b>	<b>\$1</b>	<b>\$6 per hour</b>
<b>Green zone</b>	<b>Free</b>	<b>\$3</b>	<b>\$6 per hour</b>

# Parking infringement and towage fee increases

Central government is increasing the parking infringement and towage fees across New Zealand from 1 October 2024.




## Parking fine increases include:

Overstaying not more than 30 minutes	\$20
Overstaying more than 30 minutes but not more than 1 hour	\$25
Overstaying more than 1 hour but not more than 2 hours	\$36
Park on loading zone	\$70
Park on broken yellow lines	\$100
Park vehicle of unauthorised class on reserved area (e.g. bus stop/taxi stand)	\$100
Park in an area reserved for disabled persons	\$750

## The national changes have also increased these parking fines:

Parked on lawn, garden or verge	\$70
Parked in a metered parking space without paying applicable fees	\$70
Failed to correctly activate the parking machine	\$70
